

Adult Diversion Process

The offender receives a citation from Law Enforcement for a misdemeanor type of offense.

County Attorney's office receives reports from Law Enforcement.

County Attorney's office determines if offender is diversion eligible and forwards referral information to offender.

Adult Diversion coordinator receives a copy of the referral form and a copy of the law enforcement report.

Referred offender completes the *Request for Diversion* form and returns the form to the Adult Diversion Coordinator.

Adult Diversion Coordinator reviews the Request for Diversion form, determines the level of services that will be necessary and contacts the diversion client to set up the intake.

Intake is completed: fees, court costs and restitution (as determined) are agreed upon and the contract is signed.

Upon successful completion of all contractual agreements, the adult offender's case is dismissed and the case is sealed.

If there is no successful completion, the adult diversion client is terminated from the program and scheduled to appear in court on the original charge.
