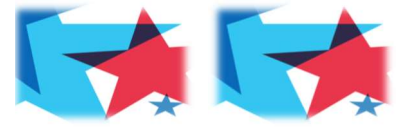


Poll Worker Qualifications



Criteria

1. Must be a registered voter in Platte County
2. Must have good eyesight & hearing
3. Must be able to read & write the English language
4. Must be able to attend a training session
5. Must be able to sit for an extended period of time
6. Cannot be a candidate appearing on the ballot
7. Must be at least 16 yrs of age, if a student worker

Duties

1. Setup polling locations prior to opening the polls at 8 am
2. Check in voters from registration list
3. Issue the proper ballot to voters
4. Tear down polling locations after polls close

Hours: 7 am to approximately 8:30 pm
