Criteria

- 1. Must be a registered voter in Platte County
- 2. Must have good eyesight & hearing
- 3. Must be able to read & write the English language
- 4. Must be able to attend a training session

- 5. Must be able to sit for an extended period of time
- 6. Cannot be a candidate appearing on the ballot
- 7. Must be at least 16 yrs of age, if a student worker

Duties
