

**PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT APPROACH ROAD
ON
PLATTE COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY
PLATTE COUNTY, NEBRASKA**

In accordance with the Board of Supervisors' policy, no approach road, field entrance, private driveway, or utility construction may be built or any work performed on a public right-of-way of a county road without a permit from the County Highway Superintendent. Any construction requiring the crossing of a county road will be subject to the discretion of the County Highway Superintendent.

All crossings of hard-surfaced roads must be done via boring. Applications for such permits must be submitted on the form provided by the County Highway Superintendent, who will determine the need, size, and length of any required drainage or utility structures. The County Board reserves the right to approve or reject the location of any approach road, driveway, field entrance, or utility structure.

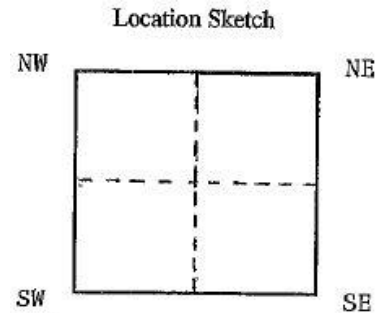
