“Shall the Village of Lindsay, Nebraska, impose a sales and use tax of 1½% of the purchase price upon the same transactions within the Village on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax?”

By-Mail Election

This election will be an election by mail. All registered voters residing within the Village of Lindsay, Nebraska, will receive their ballot by mail and therefore no polling places will be open for voting. Ballots will be mailed by the Platte County Election Commissioner between March 24th and March 28th.

Voter Registration Deadlines

The deadline to register to vote at an agency, with a deputy registrar or by mail is March 28, 2025. The deadline for in-person registration at the Platte County Election Commissioner’s Office is April 4, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.

Ballot Return Deadline

Voted ballots must be returned to the Platte County Election Commission no later than 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 15, 2025. The voter may return the ballot to the election commissioner by mailing it or by personally delivering it to the office of the Platte County Election Commissioner. The official ballot drop box is located at the Northwest corner of the Election Commission at 1464 26th Avenue.
