Proposed Amendment 2

A vote FOR this proposal will amend section 2 of the Article XIII of the Nebraska Constitution to permit the Legislature to authorize counties, cities, and villages to acquire, own, develop, lease, and otherwise finance real and personal property to be used by non profit enterprises. In empowered to authorize counties, cities and villages to issue revenue bonds for such purposes. A vote AGAINST this proposal will retain the current section 2 of Article XIII of the Nebraska Constitution and will not grant authority to the Legislature as set forth above.
