The Plan shall be funded by onetenth of the one percent (1%) local option sales and use tax in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 per year. The Plan shall be in existence for fifteen (15) years beginning April 1, 2007. The sales and use tax will provide the source of funds for the Economic Development Plan commencing April 1, 2007 and ending April 1, 2011, subject to extensions with the approval of the registered voters of the City. Assuming reauthorization of the sales and use tax, the Plan is expected to generate from the sales tax proportion allocated to it approximately \$3,000,000 over a ten (10) year term with the funds spent over a fifteen (15) year term. The City may propose to issue bonds to provide funds to carry out the Economic Development Plan. Additional funds may be sought from non-city sources beyond those derived from local sources of revenue.
