City of Columbus

Sales and Use Tax Election

Shall the City of Columbus, Nebraska impose a sales and use tax of one percent (1%) upon the same transactions within the City of Columbus on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax, commencing April 1, 2007 and shall cease being levied and collected on April 1, 2011 the revenue of which is to be applied as follows: drainage, street and capital improvements and funding for the proposed Economic Development Plan and to provide that the revenue as described above may be used to pay indebtedness incurred for the types of projects and improvements as set for above?

**Economic Development
Plan Election**

Shall the City of Columbus, Nebraska establish an Economic Development Plan as described hereby appropriating annually from local sources of revenue an amount not to exceed \$300,000 per year for ten (10) years: The goals of the Plan are: a. Promote Columbus; b. Broaden the tax base; c. Create new jobs; d. Diversify economic base; , Attract new businesses; f. Foster capital investment; g. Enhance existing businesses. h. Strengthen existing industry clusters; i. Strengthen technology skills of workforce.

The Plan shall be funded by one-tenth of the one percent (1%) local option sales and use tax in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 per year. The Plan shall be in existence for fifteen (15) years beginning April 1, 2007. The sales and use tax will provide the source of funds for the Economic Development Plan commencing April 1, 2007 and ending April 1, 2011, subject to extensions with the approval of the registered voters of the City. Assuming reauthorization of the sales and use tax, the Plan is expected to generate from the sales tax proportion allocated to it approximately \$3,000,000 over a ten (10) year term with the funds spent over a fifteen (15) year term. The City may propose to issue bonds to provide funds to carry out the Economic Development Plan. Additional funds may be sought from non-city sources beyond those derived from local sources of revenue.
