**Columbus Public Schools**  
**School Bond Election**

0001 (Columbus Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska (the District) issue bonds of said District in the principal amount of not to exceed forty-nine- million nine hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$49,915,000) for the purpose of paying the costs of site preparation and construction thereon of a new high school building and, if sufficient funds are available, modifications to the District's existing school buildings to accommodate appropriate grade levels and providing for necessary furniture and apparatus for said school buildings, said bonds to bear interest at a rate or rates to be determined by the Board of Education and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed

FOR said bonds and tax	3561
AGAINST said bonds and tax	2363

Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in said District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the interest and principal of said bonds as the same become due?

**Humphrey Public Schools**  
**School Bond Election**

Shall Platte County School District 0067 (Humphrey Public Schools) in the State of Nebraska issue bonds of said District in the principal amount of not to exceed ONE MILLION NINE HUNDRED NINETY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,995,000) for the purpose of constructing an outdoor athletic facility containing a track and football field with appurtenances and acquiring and installing necessary equipment and apparatus for said facility; said bonds to be issued from time to time, to bear interest at such rate or rates, to become due at such time or times, and to have such other terms and provisions, all as may be fixed and determined by the Board of Education of the District; and
